MAY QUEEN RETURNS

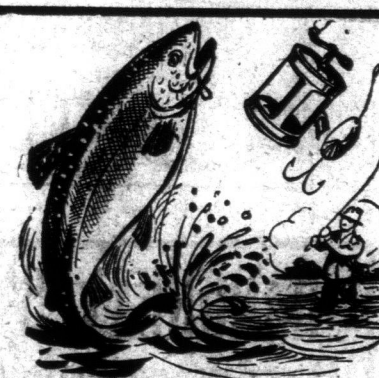
SLOW IN COMING IN
