News in Brief.

A deluge of English tenant farmers
to visit Canada, on the invitation of

Two million dollars worth of property
went up in flames at Minneapolis, Minn.,

The Mark Lane Express says that
the British wheat crop is now estimated
at 1,000,000 quarters. This leaves 21,000,000
quarters to be imported. Distinguishing stock
left over from 1897, there will be needed 10,000,000
quarters. It is not easy to see where
this supply is to come from. It will
be necessary to import wheat from
Russia, India and the United States.

Arrangements are about completed for
the exhibition of Canadian dairy products
at the World's Fair in Chicago. A
factory in Canada may send two
to three tons of butter to the fair.
The dairy products will be shipped
to Montreal or Quebec, and will
arrive there not later than September 30th.
The Dominion government will freight
the butter at the rate of 10 cents per
cwt. to Montreal or Quebec, and will
pay the cost of the freight to the
factory.
