
Kelly States Time Neede For Complete Study of Case.

Judgment has been sought on this issue by this particular firm as a test case and the decision of the judge applies to all manufacturers in the area mentioned. J. C. Elliott, K. C., and R. Not Legally Possible.

Mr. Meredith, quoting the public schools act, stated that it was not legally possible for any municipality in Ontario to exempt any part of itself from payment of school taxes, and added that according to this rule and to several decisions of the privy council the agreement made by the city in 1912 as to the annexation of Pottersburg and Ealing in regard to this exemption was illegal and that the residents out there had been granted exemption at the expense of granted exemption at the expense of the ratepayers in the rest of the city. In reserving judgement, Justice Kelly, with a large array of exhibits before him, said he needed some time in which to consult the authorities on cases cited. There was a question raised at the opening of the case by Mr. Elliott as to the authority of the supreme court in trying this case, as Mr. Elliott as to the authority of the supreme court in trying this case, as he held that only the Ontario Railway Board had the necessary authority being responsible for the original agreement. Justice Kelly leaned to the belief that his court had power to deal with this appeal, though he reserved his decision on this as in the settlement of the case itself.
