County shall devote its whole funds for the year, in-
cluding the Government Grant, in aid of the Asso-
ciation.

The payment of 5s., and upwards constitutes a
person a Member of the Agricultural Association
of Lower Canada for one year, and Two Pounds
Ten Shillings for Life, when given for that specific
object, and not as a contribution to the Local Fund.

Members of the Association are admitted to the
Show-Yard without payment, provided they make
application to the Secretary for Tickets of admis-
sion before the 8th September. All others
to pay 1s 3d. each time of entrance.—Children to
pay half-price.
