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La Presse: What has taken place in Manitoba, it cannot be repeated too often nor too loud, is a stain on the British flag, a stain that cannot be wiped away nor even concealed by hypocritically covering it with the principle of provincial autonomy. It is an act of oppression, a refusal of justice, a violation of all liberties, rendered more intricate by a spoiliation that nothing can legitimatize.

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
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
