

	October	Adoption of UN Security Council Resolution 338 calling for start of negotiations between parties concerned, under appropriate auspices aimed at establishing just and durable peace in Middle East.
1974	May	Separation of Forces Agreement signed by Israel and Syria.
	June	Establishment of UN Disengagement Observer Force to control neutral zone set up under agreement establishing Israeli–Syrian disengagement in Golan Heights.
1977	November	Egyptian President Anwar Sadat visits Jerusalem. Direct peace negotiations begin between Israel and Egypt.
1978	March	Israel invades Lebanon, which is engaged in civil war, and establishes presence in south.
	March	Adoption of UN Security Council Resolution 425 calling for withdrawal of Israel from Lebanon and respect for latter’s territorial integrity.
	March	Establishment of UN Interim Force in Lebanon to confirm Israeli withdrawal and to help Lebanon restore effective authority in its southern territory.
	September	Camp David Accords peace agreement between Egypt and Israel leads to 1982 withdrawal of Israeli forces from Sinai.
1979	March	Peace treaty between Israel and Egypt signed in Washington, D.C.
1982	April	Establishment of Multinational Force and Observers peacekeeping force in Sinai under Camp David Accords.
	June	Israel invades Lebanon, reaching Beirut. UN Security Council Resolution 509 calls for unconditional Israeli withdrawal.
1988	November	Palestinian State proclaimed by Palestine National Council at meeting in Algiers.
1989	December	Yasser Arafat, Chairman of PLO, announces acceptance of UN Security Council Resolution 242 and renounces use of terrorism. Canada subsequently lifts restrictions on level of contact with PLO and recognizes Palestinian right to self-determination in context of peace negotiations.
