(Mr. Bottomley arrives Tuesday, December 8 from Britain, Montral 1415 Ottawn approx 1515 on DOT plane at DOT terminal (Ate No. 8.) Mr. Wilson inspects a guard of honour in the RCAF hangar. Following this, Mr. Pearson welcomes Prime Minister Wilson to Canada and Mr. Wilson replies.
