Note from the United States Ambassador to Canada, His Excellency Thomas O. Enders, to the Secretary of State for External Affairs of Canada, the Honourable Don Jamieson - November 10, 1976

Sir,

I have the honor to refer to the Agreement between the Governments of the United States and of Canada effected by an exchange of Notes dated June 29, 1973, as extended by the exchange of Notes dated June 28 and 29, 1976, concerning arrangements for the use by the United States of facilities at the Goose Bay Airport, Goose Bay, Newfoundland, and to recent discussions which have taken place between representatives of our two Governments concerning arrangements for the continuing use of facilities at the Goose Bay Airport by the United States Armed Forces after the expiration of the aforementioned Agreement on September 30, 1976. As a result of these discussions, I now have the honor to propose that the conditions set forth in the attached Annex, which accord with the understandings reached between representatives of our two Governments, should govern the use of facilities at the Goose Bay Airport by the United States Armed Forces after September 30, 1976.
