D.J.Munn.Esq., -2-About 1908 or 1909 it was decided that McGill University would in future conduct its own local examinations in Music, but would not in any way interfere with the operations of the Associated Board. We have, as you know, for many years conducted examinations in Music across the continent. I am sure that I am right in saying that the attitude of McGill coincides with what Dr. McEwen states he wants not competition but co-operation.
