RESOLUTIONS unanimously adopted at the Annual Meeting of the Auxiliary Society for the District, held at Quebec, on Monday Evening, June 29, 1848. The Rev. Doctor RICHEN in the Chair.

After the reading of the Report by the Secretary, the Rev. C. Churchill, it was Resolved unanimously,

I.—That this Meeting receives with satisfaction, and recommends for distribution the Report which has now been read, and expresses its devout thanksgivings to Almighty God for the success which has attended the efforts of the Wesleyan Missionary Society, in common with other Protestant and Evangelical Institutions.

II.—That this Meeting devoutly recognizes the importance and necessity of more ferrent prayer to the Great Head of the Church for the removal of the obstacles to Missionary enterprise which still present themselves different parts of the world,—for the universal increase of zealous and devoted labourers in the mission field—and for the more copious out-pouring of the

Holy Spirit upon the Church and the world at large.

III.—That while this Meeting commends the assiduity which has marked the efforts of the various Branch Societies in this District, during the past year, it regards at the same time the aggressions and activity of the enemies of the truth, and the amount of spiritual darkness and destitution which still rests upon the heathen world, as a powerful incentive to renewed efforts;—and pledges itself to continued and increasing exertions in each department for the future.

IV.—That this Meeting thankfully recognizes the exertions of all parties who have engaged in the laudable enterprise of sustaining and extending these important Missions, and resolves that the following persons constitute the Officers and Members of this Auxiliary Society during the ensuing year:—
