



*River Pentagouit was the Western Boundary of Acadie or Nova Scotia when the limits of this were ascertained, according to the Claim of France, in Consequence of the Treaty of Breda. — the Crown of Great Britain did in 1673 Grant, the Territory lying between Sagadahoc River and the River of St. Croix, and from the edge of the Sea inland to St. Lawrence River, to the Duke of York by the name of Sagadahoc; and as this Territory was annexed to the Province of the Massachusetts Bay in 1681 by the Charter from the Crown, St. Croix River is now the Western Limits of Acadie or Nova Scotia.*

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
