CONSTITUTION,  
RULES & BY-LAWS  
OF  
No. 3 FIRE COMPANY,  
“INVINCIBLES.”

PREAMBLE.

THAT this Company shall be known and designated, “*Invincibles, No. 3 Fire Company*,” as established by and in virtue of the 31st Section of a By-Law intituled a “By-Law to establish and provide for the support of a Fire Department, and to prevent Accidents by Fire in the City of Quebec, dated the 13th March, 1844,” subject to all the Rules and Regulations that are now in force and hereafter may be made affecting said Company by said Council, &c.

That a copy of said, and all other By-Laws, &c., passed by Company shall be kept by the Secretary for the better guidance of said Company.

Constitution.

1.—That the Officers of this Company shall comprise a Captain, 1st and 2d Lieutenants, Secretary, Treasurer, Sergt.-Major, and 2 Sergeants; and, there shall also be attached to this Company a 1st, 2d, and 3d Pipeman, who shall be considered as Corporals; a 1st and 2d Axeman and a Bugler, all of whom, with the exception of the Commissioned-Officers, shall be elected, or re-elected, if the Company thinks proper,
