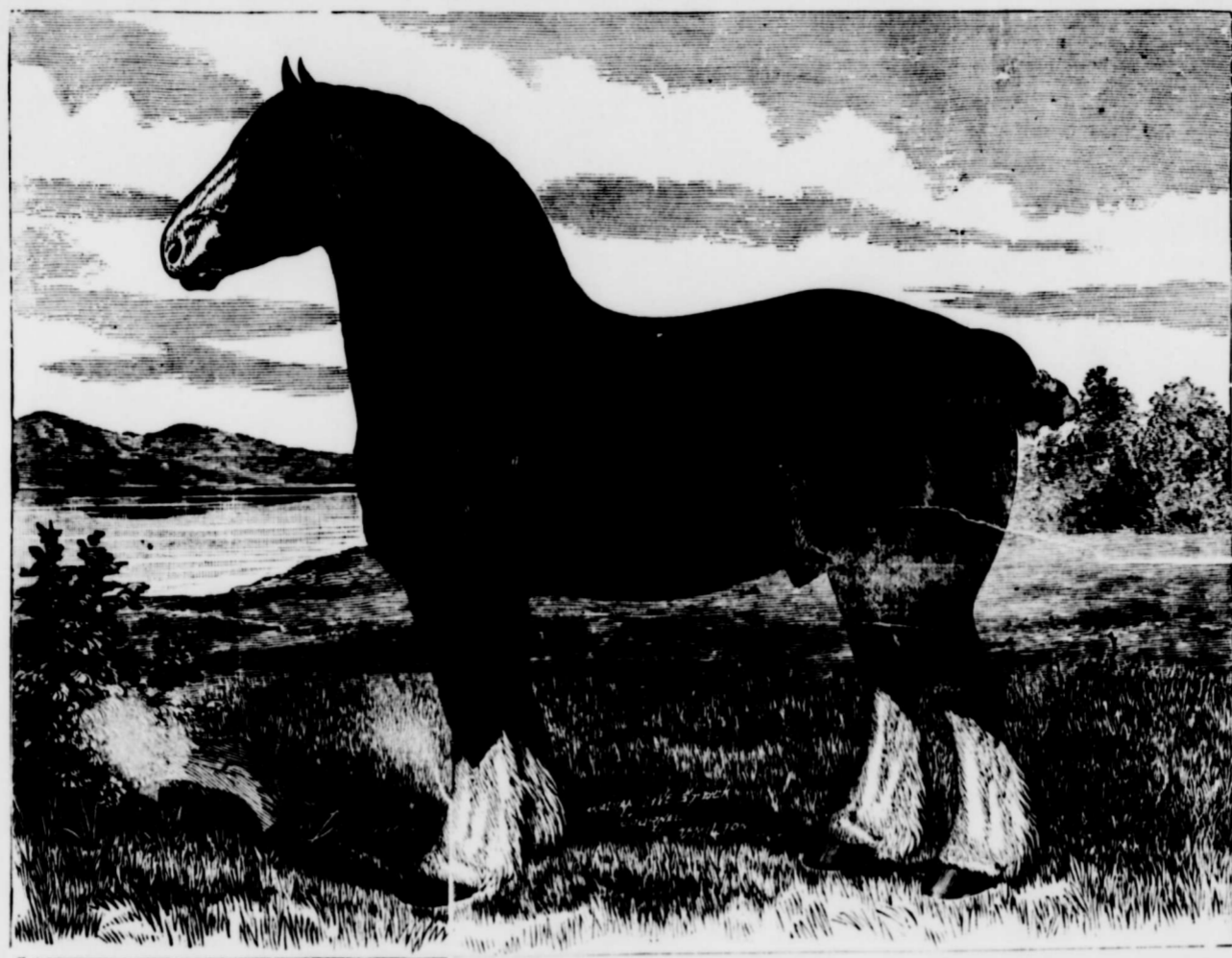

EASTFIELD LADDIE

Will serve mares for the season of 1900 as follows :

MONDAY, May 7, will leave his own stable, Bowmanville, and proceed to John Oke's, Ebenezer, night.

TUESDAY, proceed to Central Hotel, Oshawa.

WEDNESDAY, proceed to Thos. Short's, lot 4, con. 4, East Whitby, noon ; thence to Alex. Smith's, lot 30, con. 8, night.

THURSDAY, proceed to Jos. Bell's, Enniskillen, noon, thence to J. Hawkey's, Tyrone, night.

FRIDAY, proceed to Wm. Patterson's, noon ; thence to Bennett's Hotel, Newcastle, night.

SATURDAY, proceed to his own stable, Bowmanville, and remain until the following Monday noon.

The above route will be continued during the season, health and weather permitting.

TERMS : To insure a foal \$12 ; to be paid on the 1st of January, 1901. Mares must be returned regularly or they will be charged full insurance, whether in foal or not. Persons disposing of their mares before foaling time, must pay the insurance whether in foal or nor. Groom's fee 50c. No second price. All accidents to mares at owner's risk.
