

stitution and become a member of the new Rebekah Lodge without the payment of any additional admission fee, and the Rebekah Lodge issuing such transfer certificate shall, upon receiving notice from the new Lodge of the date of signing the Constitution of such Lodge, refund to such member all dues paid in advance of such date. The fee of 25 cents must be paid by the applicant.

The law applies to members who shall change their residence from one city to another as well as from one state to another. But it does not apply where there are two or more Lodges in the same city (territorial jurisdiction) and the member does not change his residence.

ARTICLE IV.

Powers and Privileges

Sec. 1. This Lodge shall possess the powers and enjoy the privileges following:

Clause —To confer the degree of Rebekah on properly qualified applicants as hereinbefore specified.

Clause 2.—To elect and appoint its own officers in the manner prescribed by this
