BAYFIELD

Population over five hundred, on Lake Shore Road, on Lake Huron, twelve miles south of Goderich.

Chief Industries: Fishing, Saw Mills, Evaporators.

Very popular Summer resort. Contains several Churches, Public School, Bank, Town Hall, etc.

BRUSSELS

Population eleven hundred, on G. T. R. Railway, in northern section of County. Convenient to Toronto and Buffalo Markets.

Chief Industries: Salt Manufacturing, Carriage Factory, Stave and Saw Mills, Flax

Mills, Metal Foundry, Cold Storage, Planing Mill, Flour Mills, Woollen Mills. Fine Agricultural Building, Public and Continuation Schools, Four Churches, Public Library, Two Banks, Music Hall, Splendid Stores, Newspaper, Brussels Post.

BLYTH

Population seven hundred, on G. T. R. Western Division, and C. P. R. Guelph to Goderich Branch.

Chief Industries: Salt Manufacturing, Saw Mills, Flax Mills, Planing Mill, Flour Mills, Foundry, Brick and Tile Yard. Contains several Churches, Four Public Schools, Two Banks, Music Hall, Public Library, Newspaper, Blyth Standard.
