Greek teachers in classic times had little liberty, poor remuneration, and they enjoyed a correspondingly low scale of social recognition. It is not easy to understand why this should have been the case; but the fact is attested by many of their own poets and oraters, who from 400 B.C. to 200 A.D. allude contemptuously to them as little better than social pariahs. One piquant quotation from the satirical poet, Lucian, well illustrates the view point. He imagines that a deceased friend comes back to pay him a visit. Lucian enquires of him in what esteem those whose tombs, embellished with elaborate sculpture and glowing inscriptions, testify to the respect in which they were held while on earth, are regarded in Hades. The ghost replies: "You never laughed so heartily as you would do if you saw the way we ireat those who have been princes and governors. They are now miserable beggars, reduced to the company of those who hawk salt fish or who teach the alphabet to children!"
