



TARIFF REFORM LIGHT.

London, Sept. 16.-It is dangerous to let our food supply come so very largely from foreign countries, instead of from British possessions. It is specially imprudent to let the United States send to us nearly all our wheat, for the top-note of American wheat production has been reached, relatively to the population of the United States, which is growing more quickly than their wheat production grows. Sooner or later, all American wheat will be wanted for consumption by the population of the United States, and long before this occurs we shall feel the effect here in the shape of a permanent rise in the price of our wheat imported from the United States.
