DECEMBER 18. The following report from the Block Sum Committee was adopted:—

"Inasmuch as the present Incumbents of Amherst and Mahone Bay appear to have been in receipt of annual payments from the S. P. G. at the present rate for more than thirty years, this Committee does not recommend the reduction suggested by the Secretary of that Society."

JANUARY 15, 1869. The Bishop stated that he had received notice from the S. P. G., that at their meeting in the following March, they would be obliged to reduce the Block Sum for Nova Scotia, at least ten per cent.

FEBRUARY 19. The question of the further acceptance of the Block Sum was brought forward. After much consideration it was resolved, that the Committee recommend the Society to request the S. P. G. to continue the agreement for another year, with as little reduction in the amount as they may feel themselves able to allow.

MARCH 23rd. It was agreed that, for this year, the limited time for sending in the returns from the parishes be extended from Mar. 31st to April 30th.

The following resolutions were adopted:—

"That this Committee accepts the expression at the public meeting recently held, as a call from the Church to go forward.

"That a Committee be appointed to make immediate efforts to enlarge the subscriptions to the D. C. S.

"That this Committee looks for corresponding efforts in every parish and district in the Province, and that this Committee will aid them as far as possible by sending deputations at such times and places as may be mutually agreed upon."

MAY 21st. A statement was submitted, showing that exclusive of the payment to meet deficit in the Block Sum, the income of the Society would be sufficient to meet all engagements entered into up to the end of 1869.

The Bishop stated that he had received notice that the reduction in the Block Sum for 1870, would be \$1375.

\$25 was granted for one year toward the expenses of Missionary visits to New Caledonia, on condition that the same amount be raised by the people there.

A draft of the 31st Annual Report was presented by the Secretary, adopted and ordered to be printed and distributed as usual.
