Referring to Departmental Letter dated the 11th of July last, No. 330490, I beg to state that there is no crossing over the British Columbia Electric Company's right-of-way through the Sahhahoum Indian Reserve of the Matsqui Band.

I would respectfully recommend that a private crossing be reserved at the point shown on the accompanying sketch, for although the Indians may not use it at the present time, yet it will be very necessary in the near future to give access from the Highway to the western portion, otherwise it will mean, that a person will have to go for several miles around to get from the eastern to the western part of the Reserve.
