

Government Also Has Begun to Pay Pensions—Full Details of Pay For Soldiers and Officers of Canada.

tion of obligatory assignment of pay in the case of men whose dependents were receiving separation allowances was considered, and the justice department recommended that "one-half of the pay of men assigned officers and men, who are members of the Canadian expeditionary force, and whose dependents are in receipt of separation allowances, shall be paid to the dependents respectively." As a result it is provided "that after April 1 each soldier's pay, while receiving separation allowance, will be paid in two parts, one part a month (being one half of the soldier's pay), making a monthly stipend from the first of the month of the year, and the other part on the 1st of the following month. This apparently is only obligatory on privates and non-coms, and not upon officers.

The separation allowances are based upon the British system though considerably higher than exist there.


It will be seen that the dependents of private soldiers are assured at least \$85 a month direct from the state, while dependents of officers are taken into account the larger separation allowances received and assuming that half of the pay received is voluntarily assigned to the dependents, comparatively small grants of allowance. On this basis a dependent of a lieutenant, for instance would receive \$70 a month; of a captain, \$105; of a major, \$125; and of a lieutenant-colonel \$155.

So much for the direct assistance from the state to the dependents of soldiers, who, of course, are not entitled to a fixed character and which takes no account of the relative circumstances of the recipients, or of the geographical conditions in which they live.

It will be noted that the amounts would in many cases be inadequate to preserve the scale of living of many of the dependents left behind. It is in such cases that the company's generosity is required, and that the company's duty is clear. For this purpose the Canadian Patriotic Fund Association was created by parliament last August. The association has its offices in Ottawa, and has innumerable branches scattered throughout the dominion. It is created by voluntary subscription on the principle that those who are able to give should give, and thus make it possible for some one else to live right instead. The contributions to the fund are headed H. B. Ames, its honorary secretary, "and

not charity; they are the spontaneous gift of a grateful people." The local committees have two duties to perform; to encourage contributions to the fund, and to supervise the disbursement of the monies among the dependents within the district which the responsible branches cover.
