**"MUTT AND JEFF" HIS OWN.** Supreme Court Action Gives Fisher Priority Right to Characters.

Washington, Nov. 17.—"Proprietary right to 'Mutt and Jeff' as characters is possessed by Harry C. 'Bud' Fisher, and decisions to that effect by the New York State courts are final, the Supreme Court refusing to hear an appeal which the Star Company, publishers of the Hearst newspapers, sought to bring.

The courts awarded Fisher exclusive right to reproduce the two characters, ordered that he be protected from unfair competition of others reproducing them, and rejected the contention of the Star Company that Fisher could copyright only particular pictures and words descriptive of their exploits in incidents drawn by him, and that the two characters were public property.

A drinking glass stained with Paris green and a package containing the poisonous powder found on the floor were written in pencil, in which Waugh bade goodbye to the girl of his affections.
