Paris, Dec. 10—Aeronautical experts have pointed out often that it is dangerous for the Allies to permit the Germans to build new air machines or to use their powerful old ones unless the Allies limit and control their use. Such fears seem fully justified by a document published by Le Journal. A photograph shows a huge German machine which was captured by the Roumanians in Bessarabia when the machine, which was flying to Russia, was forced to descend because of engine trouble. The pocture in itself is nothing remarkable, except that it shows the size of the machine, which is one used to bomb London during the war. But the conte of its passenger cabin throws new light on the allied German undertakings with

Soviet Russia. The cargo of the machine, which was piloted by two German officers, with the aid of three mechanics, included 260,000,000 roubles (normally
