U. S. Firms Awarded \$40,000,000 Job To Rebuild Rheims, Nancy and Soissons Areas

Paris, June 10.—Contracts for reconstruction work aggregating 300,000,000 francs (nearly \$40,000,000), covering the rebuilding of the destroyed area of Rheims, Nancy and Soissons, have been awarded to American firms, according to an announcement here.

The official representatives of the chief company—a steel corporation—are now on their way to the United States.
