Q.68. What is your rank, name and unit?

A.68. Lieut. P. G. Morris, Staff, Aldershot Training Centre,
A.14, C.I.T.C.

Q.69. Do you know the accused?

A.69. I do sir.

Q.70. What is his name?

A.70. Pte. Lilley sir.

Q.71. Did you see him on the 20th December, 1943?

A.71. I did sir.

Q.72. Yes. Will you tell the Court where and what you were
doing that day?

A.72. On December 20th, 1943, on instructions from the Adjutant,
A.14 C.I.T.C., I investigated a case involving the loss of some money by
Lieut. I. G. Wood, also of this training centre. As a result of my investigation,
the accused, Pte. Lilley, gave me this receipt. (Handing paper to the Court).

THE DEFENDING OFFICER

I object to the admission of that receipt in evidence. On authority of District Headquarters certain exhibits will be removed from the Court-Martial proceedings. This is one of the exhibits. It is not relevant and N.D.H.Q. states it should not be presented.
