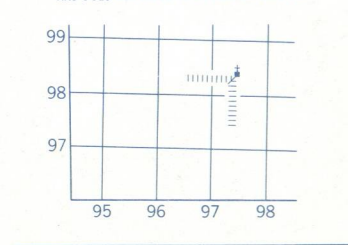

EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES



REFERENCE POINT	CHURCH (as above)
EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point.	97
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point.	97.5
EXAMPLE MILITARY GRID REFERENCE	979504

Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 63 miles)

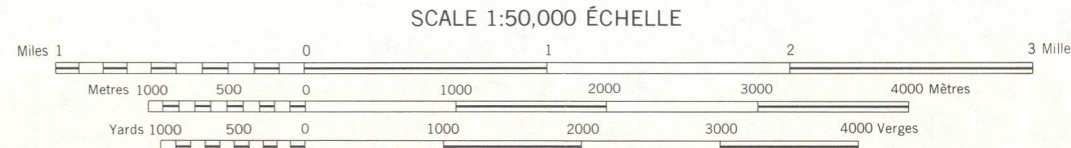
BROWN NUMBERED TICKS INDICATE THE 1000 METRE U.T.M. GRID
