

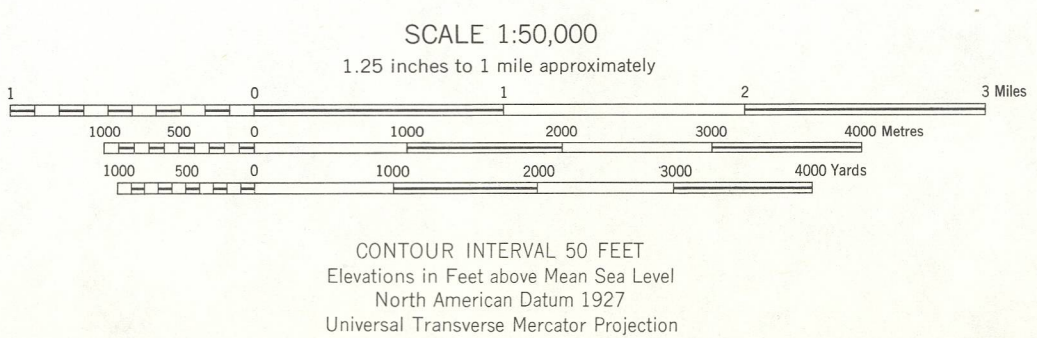

MAGNETIC DECLINATION 39°06' WEST AT CENTRE OF MAP 1958 Annual magnetic change 9' easterly

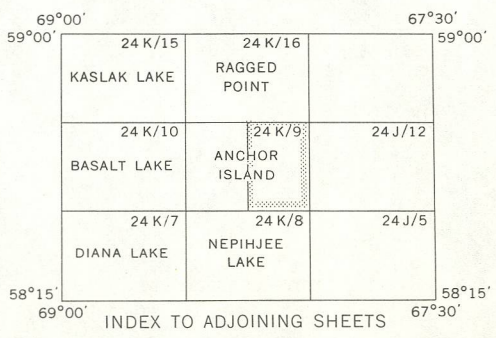
