ELLIOTT'S HOTEL, Plowing With Dynamite. Plowing With Dynamite. Sub-soil plowing with dynamite is one of the new methods in the south, and it is said to be equal to the process of trenching used by market gardeners to lossen the earth to a depth of two or three feet and allow the absorbtion of a good deal of water for sustaining vegetation during a drought. The inventor drills holes two or three feet deep and five feet apart, making 1,600 to the acre.
