

BYE-LAWS.

ARTICLE I.

Sect. 1. The Prov. S O shall appoint a standing committee on Credentials, one on Communications, one on the State of the Order, one on Constitutions and Bye Laws, and one on Finance.

Sec. 2. The Committee on Credentials shall, as soon as possible after the opening of the Prov. Club, retire to the ante room, receive and investigate the credentials of candidates, and report to the Prov. Club.

Sec. 3. The Committee on Communications shall investigate all documents which come before the Prov. Club, and report thereon.

Sec. 4. The Committee on the State of the Club shall ascertain its condition from all available sources, and they shall have the privilege of access to all books and papers that may aid them in arriving at correct conclusions.

Sec. 5. The Committee on Constitutions and Bye Laws shall examine the Constitutions in accordance with the bye laws, to see that they shall also be their duty, to see that they complaints touching the same in the order. It shall also be their duty to see that they comply with the bye laws.

Sec. 6. The Committee on Finance shall investigate and report upon all accounts coming before the Prov. Club.

ARTICLE II

Any member in good standing in any subordinate club may be admitted as a visitor to the
