

A wine account will be kept separately and the books and stock will be balanced every week by the mess President before he is relieved from his duty.

The mess sergeant will wear a plain black dress coat, with black vest in winter and a white vest in summer, white necktie and black pants.

23 The officers' servants of the corps being supplied with the regimental livery, they will all attend on guest nights and one of them will be detailed weekly to attend dinner only. X

24 The Commandant's servant will attend each time the Commandant comes to mess, but not otherwise.

25 No officer should, on any account, enter the ante room with his cap on or with his sword. X

26 No smoking will be permitted in the ante-room for a space of one hour before dinner.

27 On the first bugle sounding ($\frac{1}{2}$ an hour before dinner) no officer in plain cloths should, on any pretext whatsoever, enter the ante room without special leave from the senior officer present.

28 At the second bugle (5 minutes before dinner) every officer should be in the ante-room
