Wood, *Hon.* Edmund Burke, [*Brant, S. R.*]

S. of Mr. Samuel Wood, of Co. Halton
Ont., who migrated from the United States
to Canada, during the American War of 1812
B. near Chippawa, Niagara River, 14 Feb.
1817. Ed. at Oberlin College, State of Ohio
U. S., where he graduated in 1848. M. in
April, 1855, Jane Augusta, second dau.
Dr. Peter Martin, of Brantford. Called to the
Bar, U. C., in 1855. Was first Clerk of the
County Court and Clerk of the Crown when
the Co. Brant was erected into a new county
in 1853. Appointed a mem. of the Ex. Coun-
cil and Treasurer of the Province of Ontario
July 1867. Sat for present seat in Leg. As-
sembly, Can., from g. e. 1863 until the Union.
Represents Brant, S. R., in Local House.
