An Act to authorize the Cobourg and Peterborough Bailway Company to construct a Tramway or Bailway from the Mermora Iron Works to the River Trent, or to Rice Lake, and for other purposes.

WHEREAS the Cobourg and Peterborough Rdilyay Company Preamble. have petitioned for power to establish a line of water-communication between Harwood on Rice Luke, and some point on the River Trent, and to construct a trainway or railway from the River Trent to 5 Marmora, so as to connect with the Marmora Iron Works; and whereas, it is advisable to grant the said powors as well as other powers incidental thereto, or connected with the same subject: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

10 1. The said Cobourg and Peterborough Railway Company are author-G. and P. orized to build, purchase, possess and hold one or more vessels to be pro-Railway Co. pelled by steam or other power, with all such necessary scows, boats my build, and barges as may be required to be used and employed in the waters of Rice Lake and the River Trent, by the said company
15 for the purposes, and in connection with the objects and undertakings referred to in this Act.

The said Company are authorized to construct a tramway or rail-Comparymay way, to run from any point in the River Trent to any other point or construct points in the Township of Marmora, and to purchase, acquire and hold tramway or railway from 20 all necessary locomotives, rolling stock, matters and things which may River Trent be required, and to use the same, in carrying iron and other ores, mer- to Marmora.

The following clauses of "the Railway Act" are incorporated Certain with this Act, that is to say, the first, second, third and fourth clauses clauses of 25 thereof, and the clauses relating to "Powers, Plans and Surveys, Lands and Railway Act their valuations," except in so far as they may be inconsistent with this corporated. Act.

4. The Cobourg and Peterborough Bailway Company are authorized C. & P. Bailto unite with the Marmora Iron Company, with the consent of a two-way Co may 30 third majority of the shareholders, and proprietors of each of the said Com-Marmora Iron panies, for the purpose of mining for ores, minerals, marble and any Works Co. for other valuable substances, and of smelting any such ores and mineral certain pursubstances, and of carrying and conveying the same to market by the poses. said route, and generally for all the purposes of this Act, and any pro-85 visional or final agreement between the said companies with the

consent of a majority of shareholders, shall be binding.

The said companies may for the more effectual carrying into effect Companies of such union, consolidate their respective debts and unite their stocks, may unite.
