

Sheriff or other Officers not conforming to the requisites of this Act may be fined by the Court &c.

long, shall summon and return any person to serve as a Juror in any of the aforesaid Courts, whose name is not inserted in the duplicates transmitted to him by the Clerk of the Peace in virtue of this Act, and if any Clerk of the Crown, or his Deputy, or Clerk of any Court of Oyer and Terminer or General Gaol delivery, as Clerk of the Peace, shall record the appearance of any person so summoned and returned who did not really appear, then, and in such case, any Court before whom such officer shall have been committed, shall, upon examination in a summary way, set such fine or fines upon such Sheriff, Officer or Clerk, for every such offence, as to the said Court shall seem meet, and not exceeding ten pounds nor less than forty shillings,

Justices of the Peace may cause to be struck out from the lists the names of persons not qualified to serve as Jurors.

XVI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that if any person, not qualified to serve on Juries in any of the Courts before-mentioned, shall find his name inserted in any such list, and shall complain thereof to the Justices in their General Quarter Sessions, and apply to have his name struck from such list, it shall be lawful for the said Justices upon proof before them, made by the oath of the party complaining or otherwise, that he is not qualified to serve as a Juror according to this Act, to order his name to be struck from such list, and the same shall be entered in a book to be kept by the Clerks of the Peace for that purpose.

No person shall be returned as a Juror who has served within one year next preceding.

XVII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that no person shall be returned as a Juror to serve on Trials in any of the Courts before mentioned, who shall have served as Juror in any of the said Courts within the space of one year next preceding, and if any Sheriff or other Officers having the return of Juries shall offend therein, the Court before which such offence shall be committed is required, on examination and proof of such offence in a summary way, to set a fine or fines upon every such offender, not exceeding five pounds for any one offence.

Sheriff offending &c. may be fined.

Sheriffs shall enter in a book the names &c. of persons summoned as Jurors, and the terms of their service.

XVIII And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that every Sheriff and other Officer, to whom the Return of Juries shall be long, shall from time to time enter or register in a book, the names of such persons as shall be summoned and shall serve as Jurors in any of the before mentioned Courts, together with their additions and places of abode alphabetically, and also the terms of such their service, and
