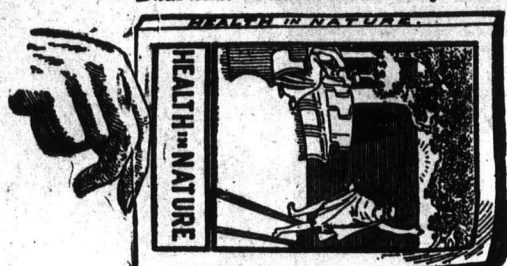
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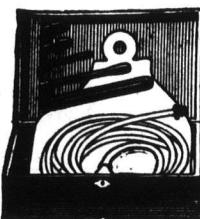

"Because, sir, I'm a vegetarian."

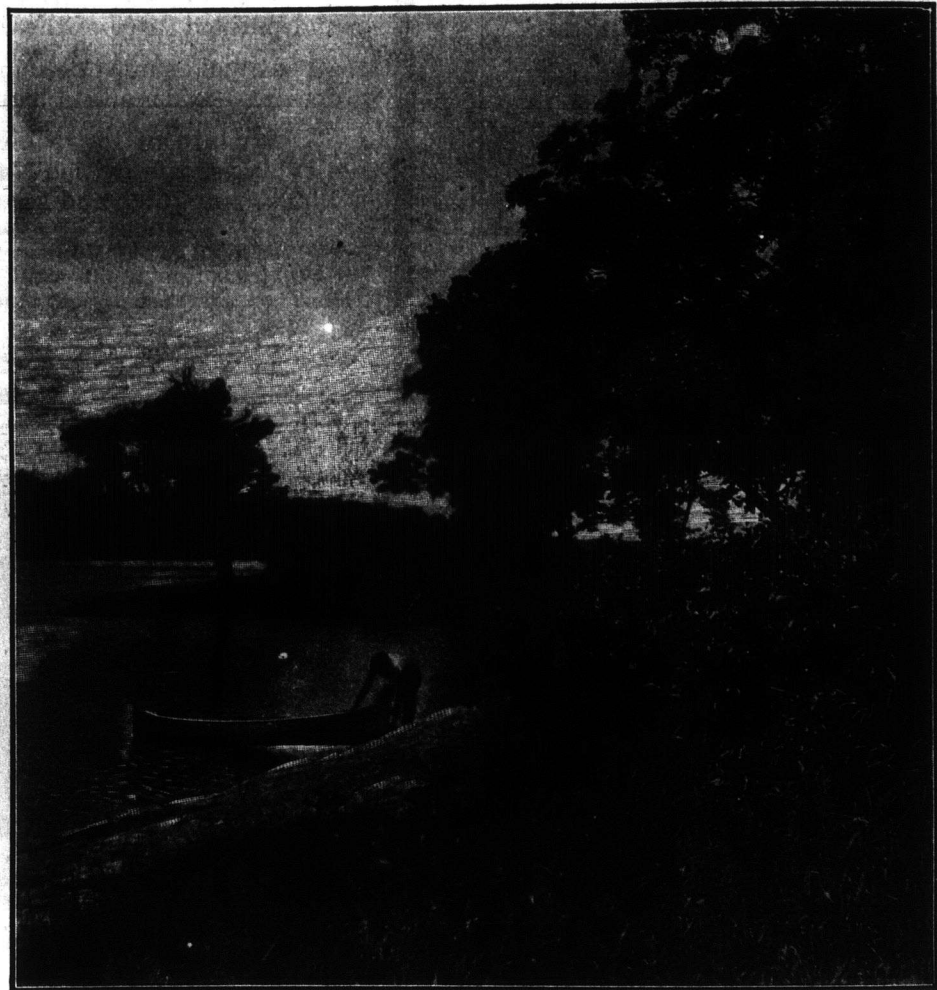
The Higher Strategy.

And a pitying glance went backward towards the table where the manager was calmly disposing of a bowl of bread and milk. A fancy income means the simple life.

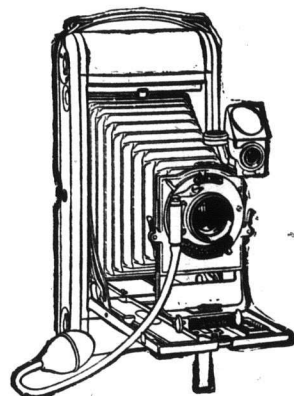
Against His Convictions.
