A perceptible rise in bank rates of interest is now on hand over the border, and without doubt the change will make itself felt in Canada.

The other day the New York bank statement for last week made a surprise on commercial circles. That statement showed that a third of the surplus held on July 31 had vanished in one week.

The New York Tribune in its weekly review during the fall of the surplus money, with over \$50,000,000 in the city last week, the market continued easy through the crop-moving period, but since that time over \$75,000,000 paper circulation has been retired or taken by the treasury, and the bank surplus shown by last week's report was only \$20,000,000.

The Montreal Herald rightly remarks that one thing in which Canada may yet ought to become independent in a separate cable system over the C. P. R. and Mackay's proposed systems. The Canadian press and its readers have been long afflicted and sometimes irritated by public news which is specially prepared for the New York market, while Canadian interests have been practically ignored.
