Grand River 19th Feby 1812 311

In obedience to His Honor the President's late Proclamation, alluding to the Grand River Settlement, I beg to inform you that, I hold a Lease (from M^{rs} Catharine Brant, widow, for lot N^o 10 on the south side the road leading thro. the Swamp, to the Mohawk Village containing about 230 acres which land, I contracted for (long since), with the late Capt Brant for one Dollar P^r acre - and have resided ever since on the said premises, and have an extensive

improvement -) dated 23rd March 1811. and Witnessed by E^p L. Phelps, and Jacob Brant

I hold an other lease from the aforesaid M^{rs} Brant for lots N^o 3 & 4 on the North side the aforesaid ^{road} containing about 300 acres, which Land, I Purchased from Mary Poulas and Isaac Brant being Lots allowed the aforesaid heirs according to the Will of the late Cap. Brant, and gave one Dollar P^r acre - which lease is dated the 7th Sep^r 1811 - and Witnessed by J. G. Staats & E^p L. Phelps both Leases for the term of 999 years -
