



Sir,-

I have your letter of the 5th instant, with reference to patent issued by this Department covering lighthouse site at the North West corner of the Paskonkin Reserve No. 15 purchased in 1887 for the sum of \$175.25 by the Department of Marine and Fisheries. In June, 1920, this Department re-possessed the land as it was no longer required for lighthouse purposes and I enclose certified copy of Order in Council, for your records, of the 29th June, 1920, in this connection. On the first of June, 1921, the Rainy River Band of Indians surrendered the land for sale and in December the same year we disposed of the location to Halver Jenson and patent issued to him on completion of the purchase.
