Cut thereon without ficeuse. and you will warm the delinguents Fraser and Parton that their unlawful Conduct must be punished recording to law. You will also notify Eteamboat auceus, Captains, and others that the Cordwood and Timber in that licenty arie the property of the Indias Defourtment and
