
Ottawa, 8th June, 1905.

Sir,-

Under instructions from this Department, Mr. S. Bray, Chief Surveyor, will proceed to Deseronto on Saturday to value the land, improvements and damages, in connection with the right of way of the Bay of Quinte Railway through the Church property, in the Tyendinaga Indian Reserve, and will endeavour to arrange the matter between the Church authorities and the Railway Company; kindly notify them of the fact.

He will also look into the matter generally of the land taken by the Railway Company for the right of way in the reserve, as there appears to be some indefiniteness regarding its boundaries. I have to request you to be good enough to give him all the assistance in your power.
