Sir,-

Last Spring the Department supplied the Long Plain Band of Indians with seed potatoes costing \$30.08 and seed grain costing \$196.90 upon the understanding that the cost would be refunded this Fall.

You should therefore collect these amounts from the Indians through the Farm Instructor, Mr. Hampson without delay and remit to the Department.


Seed grain costing \$194.95 was also supplied Sandy Bay Reserve upon the same terms as Long Plain Band and this amount should also be collected by you and forwarded to the Department.

You may inform the Indians that unless these refunds are made they need not look to the Department for any further assistance in this direction.

Collections should also be made through the Farm Instructors from the Swan Lake and Rosseag River Bands for the seed grain supplied them.

Unless these refunds are made the Department will not in future supply the Indians with seed and you should so inform them.
