To multiply examples of this form of labour-saving device is unnecessary; they would include the collection into a large basket of all ornaments, loose books or papers, etc. in a room which is to be cleaned, so that all can be

removed in one journey, thus saving countless steps to and fro; the use of large dust-sheets, with which all furniture can be covered before the room is swept; the protection of the hair in kitchen and house work by wearing a sunbonnet or large enveloping cap, and so on.
