VI.—No English-speaking children shall be admitted into the schools, save in such exceptional cases as shall be sanctioned by the Committee.

VII .- The clergyman who has charge of the schools and the general oversight of the Institution, shall be styled the PRINCIPAL.

VII.—No Teachers or Agents shall be engaged in the schools, or other departments of the Mission, without the advice of the Superintendent and the sanction of the Committee.

IX.—The chief aim of the Committee, in conducting the Mission, shall be to reach the French Roman Catholic population, especially by the engagement of Colporteurs, and, through them, to bring Roman Catholic Children into the AUX
