The Church of Ireland Gazette refers to such a family in the recent editorial reference which follows: "The new Dean of Connor, the Rev. Wil-

liam Dowse, is one of three brothers occupying important positions in the Irish Church. Canon John Dowse is rector of Monkstown, and a Diocesan Nominator for Dublin; Canon Charles Dowse is Incumbent of Christ Church, Leeson Park, and Professor of Pastoral Theology; while the new Dean is Incumbent of one of the most important parishes in Belfast, and known as one of the most strenuous and high-minded parish clergy in the city. The new Dean was ordained in 1879, was for some time Curate of Monkstown, when His Grace the Archbishop of Dublin was Rector, and in 1892 succeeded the late Bishop Welland as Rector of St. Thomas's."
