

PROCLAMATION.

BY HIS EXCELLENCY

SIR JOHN WENTWORTH, BARONET, L.L.D.

Lieutenant Governor and Commander in Chief, in and over His Majesty's Province of Nova-Scotia, and its Dependencies, &c. &c.

THEREAS the General Assembly of this Province stands prorogued to Thursday the 20th day of March instant:

I have therefore thought fit, further to prorogue the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY, to the 21st of June next, then to meet for the Dispatch of Business, of which all persons concerned, are hereby required to take notice, and govern themselves accordingly.

GIVEN under my Hand and Seal at Arms at Halifax, this 5th day of March, 1804, in the 44th year of His Majesty's Reign.
