



The English hymn, "God Save the King," appeared in its present form in 1740, and made its way by its merits until it became

officially recognized. Although Germany has a patriotic song to the same air, "The Watch on the Rhine," now known abroad as the great national song, did not appear till 1870. The French hymn of "The Marseillaise" was produced during the excitement of the Revolution, as "The Star-Spangled Banner" was inspired by an incident of the War of 1812.
