Synopsis of Canadian North

West Land Regulations

Any person who is the sole head of tamily, or any male over 18 years old. may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manl. obe. Sakatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending

Duties Six months' reddence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within pine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres aclely owned and occupied by him or by his father. other, son, daughter, brother or sis-

In certain districts a bomesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his hemestead. Price \$3.00 per acre

Duties-Must reside upon the home. stead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required a homestead patent) and cultivate fifty

A homesteader who has oxhausted his homesteed right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may enter for a purchas. ad homestead in certain districts. Price \$.. 00 per acre. Duties .- Must recide six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a honer
