

The report recommends a careful orders-in-council, regulations, concerning the timber of the province, that they should be co-ordinated and, where necessary or advisable, amended to make a consistent code of the law governing the matter. This code should be printed and furnished to every agent, culler, and other officers of the department, as well as to every concessionaire.

Returns by cullers were found to be unreliable, and the report remarks that the system followed in the department would not be tolerated in any business institution.
