

The Residence Rule.

Under the residence rule a player must be a bona fide and continuous resident of the town to which his club belongs since August 1 1917. The exceptions are enlisted soldiers, students, boys on farm work or other national service, teachers and sailors. The last named must play where they were living last January.

Soldiers enlisted for werseas service may pkay in heir home towns with a soldiers' team in the town or regimental district in which they are located or
