Hanover Offers Mr. Knechtel

Bonus of \$25,000 To Do So

Hanover, Ont., Jan. 2.—There is a

fair probability that the establish-

ment of the Knechtel Furniture Co.,

which was recently destroyed by fire

here, will be replaced before long.

For the past couple of weeks the com-

pany has been doing the best that

adverse circumstances permitted.

They have rented for one year the

premises of the Hanover Furniture

Company, where they have given em-

ployment to about 50 of their old men.

Arrangements have also been made

by them for handling in other places

all their orders until such time as the

factory is rebuilt. The town of Han-

over has offered to Mr. Knechtel a

bonus of \$25,000, and it is generally

supposed that this would induce him

to rebuild. It remains to be seen,

however, whether the situation will
