



BEAVER MANUFACTURING CO., GALT:—

Gentlemen,—I have fed Herbage in according to directions and found it to be profitable. I fed my three cows 4 lbs each, costing 50c per cow. I commenced three weeks before they came in, and feed for about 3 weeks after, and then put them on grass. My neighbors had full better cows, yet on no better pasture, mine at the end of the six month's delivery Nov. 1st, returned me from \$1 to \$6 more per cow. One of them had 30 cows. I urged him to test Herbageum. He replied: "It costs too much."
