In thez forms ther is a slît chanj belo the lîn ev sît. This chanj apers not enuf for lejibility. Forms lîk p, q, j, y, hav stud a test ov senturis ov experiens—Jj only $t\pi$ senturis. J can hardly be considered a very gud shep, oltho wîdly yuzd by diferent pepls; and "mind yur p's and q's' is a proverb. Had jits tel prolengd enuf tu mek it reverted j, it mit du. u wil not du, whîl y me. We must hav botm distincishes at lest as lejibl as thozov p, q, j or y.

—Orthografy is won thing, Orthopy is another. The later aproximats the former. the exijensis ov printing, se a larj dely peper, ar considerd with its hury, its telegrams, and its nît-wurk, it is manifest that comon requisits ov Orthoepy, tu se nuthing ov its nîsetis, canot be fulfild. In it, we must sho: 1, acsnt, which wil comonly be index enuf tu quentity; 2, fonetic silabicashn, not elwaz îdentical with etumolojic silabicashn, as Bel sez, sep 103; 3, quelity ev sounds, shoing a. simpl unvocalîzd breth, which is distinct from u, a regular vowel. Orthografy duz not go so far, but, insted, ofn shoz composishn or orijin ov a wurd.

—Her is a sampl ov distinct, as distinguisht from coloquial or mumbling orthopy. Acsent 1st silabl ecsept markt on secnd. Sound th as in "thin."
